Dates: June 14-16, 2024
June 13, 5:30-8:00pm Captain's Meeting
Location: Atlantic Ocean, leave & return through Chincoteague Inlet
Lines In: 6:30am (may not leave CI before 3:00am on fishing day)
Weigh In: 5:30pm



Rules:

Boats can only fish 2 of 3 days, Captain's choice.
Only one day needs to be fished for the tournament to be official.
Only if tournament committee cancels the tournament, full refunds will be given.
Rod and reel only. Trolling, Jigging, Chunking are allowed. **NO GREENSTICKING**
Species is tuna and dolphin only and any legal, **non-mutilated**, tuna or dolphin is eligible according to HMS regulations.
May not leave inlet before 3:00am. Fish must be weighed the same day they were caught.
If there are no tuna or dolphin weighed, names will be drawn for each prize. (1 prize per Captain in drawing)
If there is no daily fish weighed, names will be drawn for each prize for those Captains who did NOT lay that day.
Discounted **PAID IN FULL** entry due by Wednesday, May 8th at the monthly FSA meeting. Entry form **MUST** accompany payment.
FSA and tournament directors reserve the right to update and ammend the rules, or cancel tournament up until the Captain's Meeting.

Weigh In:

5:30pm at Curtis Merritt Harbor. FISH MUST BE CHECKED IN (in person) **BEFORE** 5:30pm. No weighing of unchecked fish.
Group weigh-in: **Only 1 bigeye, 3 tuna (other than bigeye) and 1 dolphin per day can be weighed in.**
No culling on the official scale. Captain or representative must be present with fish at weigh ins. Fish may NOT be trucked in.

Entry Allocations per boat (except for Average):

Tuna Stringer: \$250 - 3 winners 55/30/15 split for the 3 heaviest tuna stringers (up to 3 fish) - EXCLUDES bigeye tuna -
Dolphin: \$125 - 3 winners 55/30/15 split for the 3 heaviest dolphin (May not be a part of daily calcutta)
Big Tuna: \$75 - WTA (May not be a part of daily calcutta)
Daily Tuna/Dolphin: \$150 - Total divided among 3 days with 70(tuna)/30(dolphin) split. One winner per species, per day.
Average: \$750 total (provided by club) Tuna/Dolphin with the weight closest (not to exceed) to the **average** fish weights

Captain's Meeting: (food, shirt sales, raffle, 50/50, rules, Q&A, bad jokes, etc.)

Thursday, June 13th, 5:30-8pm at **Curtis Merritt Harbor Marina., Chincoteague, VA.**
Entries will be accepted at Captain's meeting. Captain's bags must be picked up at meeting.
All balances **MUST** be paid in full and entry forms filled out and signed - **CASH ONLY - NO DISCOUNTS**

Lay Day:

Lay day declaration must be sent via **text only** to 240-367-0247 By 6:00am the day you wish to lay. (Clarify Captain, boat & day)
If no text is received, or received AFTER 6:00am, that day is considered a fishing day.
If no lay day is declared Friday or Saturday, then Sunday will be your lay day.

Payouts: (to be given at July member meeting)

Tuna Stringer - 55% to the heaviest weighed; 30% to the 2nd heaviest weighed, 15% 3rd heaviest tuna stringer
Dolphin - 55% to the heaviest weighed; 30% to the 2nd heaviest weighed, 15% 3rd heaviest dolphin (May not be a part of daily)
Big Tuna - Winner Take All (May not be a part of daily calcutta)
Daily Fish - Total divided among 3 days with 70%(tuna)/30%(dolphin) split. One winner each category, each day.
Average - Club provides \$750 with a 70/30 split between the Tuna/Dolphin with the weight closest (not to exceed) to the **average** of all tuna/dolphin weighed. One each category.
Your single fish will be placed to the highest payout.
